



**VII. Fee Clarification**

**Item #2, Mobile Home Park Site:** When item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. When setting a mobile home in a park, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe. On private property #'s 1, 16, inspections required and any other items to be installed.

**Item #24, Domestic Water Treatment and Filtering Equipment:** A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #24 for \$10.00 each and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

**THERE IS A \$85 MINIMUM PERMIT FEE- Includes one (1) inspection**

**IX. Instructions for Completing Application**

**Make checks payable to: "Bridgeport Charter Township"**

**General:** Plumbing work shall not be started until the permit application has been filed with Bridgeport Charter Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the current Michigan Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call the Building Department at least 24 hours prior to the inspection. Any questions regarding this permit application may be directed to the Plumbing Inspector (989) 777-0940 Ext. 214 or Building Official (989) 777-0940 Ext. 215.

**Expiration of Permit:** A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE**

**DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
